

Stelios Matamis **Mphil in Brewing and Distilling, Herriot-Watt University of Edinburgh Scotland**

Stelios Matamis was born in Thessaloniki in 1981 but grew up in Dijon Bourgogne, therefore his early recollections are full of pictures of wine cellars and vineyards.
